



Downtown Culpeper Parking Information

Overview of the Culpeper Parking Authority

The Town of Culpeper Parking Authority was created in 1979 by the Virginia General Assembly to oversee off-street public parking.

The goal of the Parking Authority is to promote the economic development of Downtown Culpeper by providing convenient, attractive and safe parking at a reasonable cost to residents, property owners, merchants, businesses and customers.

Parking Management Program

Use the attached map to find various parking lots throughout the Downtown area. The Town of Culpeper Planning & Community Development Department administers permit and residential parking permits. Permit Parking Rates
\$20.00 per month per space.

Residential Parking Rates \$10.00 to \$30.00 per space per year, depending on off-street parking conditions.

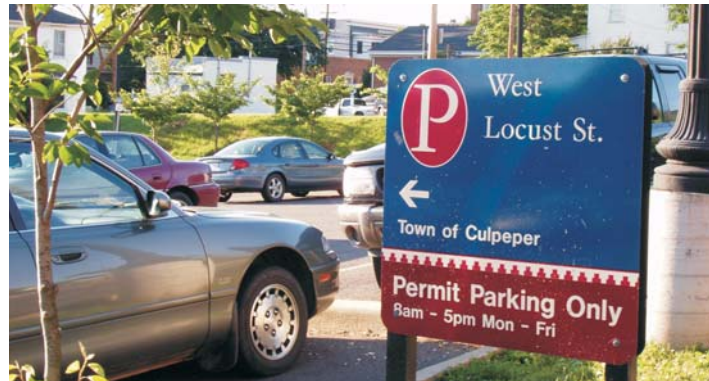

What's on the Horizon

- 1. Completion of Ann Wingfield Parking Lot.** Located at East & Spencer Street, this expanded parking lot will add 48 new permit parking spaces.
- 2. Construction of Triangle Parking Lot.** Located on Commerce & Spencer Street, this new parking lot will add 70 FREE - all day parking spaces in the Depot District. This lot is available for Amtrak customers.
- 3. E. Davis Street/Commerce Street Parking Lot.** Due to its convenient location to businesses, this lot will change regulations from all-day to 3-hour parking once the Triangle Parking Lot is completed.
- 4. Overbooking of Permit Parking.** Beginning January 1, 2005, all permit parking lots will be overbooked 10%. There will be no assigned spaces - the spaces will be available on a first-come/first-served basis.
- 5. Downtown Parking Garage.** Tentative plans for a new downtown parking garage are under consideration. A location has not been determined at this time. As the Town reaches build-out, which is anticipated in 2007-2008, a parking garage will likely become inevitable.

Map of Parking Lots

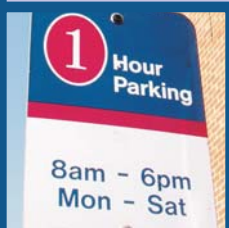
Parking Key
